

MINT ReportBuilder Advanced

Course Description

General

This training features the more sophisticated functionalities of the ReportBuilder. You will learn how to set up and test event handlers for event driven execution and timed events. You will also practice using templates for sending training invitations and schedule changes.

Part I will deal with automation, Event Handlers and Report distribution to Instructors and Trainees. Part II will focus on programming features of the ReportBuilder.

You definitely don’t need to be a Java programmer to attend, but a basic knowledge of any programming language will help.

Prerequisites

You need to understand the basics of MINT ReportBuilder with some practical experience or considerable knowledge of other standard report builders.

Content

Hands-on examples will cover:

- Event and time driven report execution and distribution
- Setting up automatic training invitations, schedule change notifications and data exports.
